# Cottage Country Collection



Starting Tuesday May 25th, and ending the week of October 4th 2010, regular curbside collection in Cottage Country will take place. The cycle begins and ends with garbage collection. There is a six garbage bag limit per household. Remember to sort your paper and container recyclables into separate clear or blue bags.

Collection days for each area are listed below:

## South Colchester—Mondays

This includes the private roads in the Shortt's Lake area.

## North Colchester—Tuesdays

This includes: Mattatall Lake, Bayhead, Tatamagouche, Sandpoint, Barrachois, Brule Shore and Brule Point.

## West Colchester—Thursdays

This includes communities west of and including Glenholme, Folly Lake, Great Village, Little Dyke, Portapique, Five Houses, Bass River, Economy, Five Islands and all points in between.



## Household Hazardous Waste Disposal

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) is leftover household products that contain corrosive, toxic, ignitable or reactive ingredients. Products such as paints, cleaners, oils, batteries, antifreeze and pesticides require special care when disposed of. Proper disposal protects our health and our environment.
