Recyclables Processing  
Agreements

“That the Municipality enter into a 5-year recyclables processing agreement with the Valley Waste Management Authority for the period April 1, 2003 to March 31, 2008, at a rate of \$45 per tonne and that the Mayor and Chief Administrative Officer be authorized to sign this agreement; and,

That the Municipality enter into a 5-year extension of the recyclables processing agreement with the Pictou County District Planning Commission for the period October 1, 2002 to September 30, 2007, at a rate of \$45 per tonne, and that the Mayor and Chief Administrative Officer be authorized to sign this agreement; and,

That the Municipality enter into a 5-year recyclables processing agreement with the District of East Hants for the period January 8, 2003 to January 7, 2008, at a rate of \$45 per tonne, and that the Mayor and Chief Administrative Officer be authorized to sign this agreement.”
