



**Municipality of the County of Colchester
Low Income Municipal Tax Assistance Program**

SUBMISSION DEADLINE – FRIDAY MAY 8, 2026

Residential property owners may be eligible for an exemption on their 2026/2027 property taxes of \$652.20. To qualify, applicants must own and occupy the property as your principal residence and fall into one of the categories in the table below:

<u>Family Size</u>	<u>Gross Income</u>	<u>Exemption</u>
Single	Less than \$32,310	\$652.20
Family of 2	Less than \$42,676	\$652.20
Family of 3 or more	Less than \$51,213	\$652.20

Gross Income refers to total gross income from all sources for the calendar year ending **December 31, 2025**, excluding War Veterans Allowance Act (Canada), Pension from Veteran Affairs Canada and HST Rebates. You **must include** the income of all members of the household over the age of 18, except full-time students.

When submitting your completed application to the Municipal Tax Office, **you must bring a copy of one of the following for each applicable member of the household:**

- **2025** Filed Income Tax Return, **OR**;
- **2025** Notice of Assessment, **OR**;
- If you have filed via telephone through the File My Return service, please request a proof of income statement to provide as proof of income. Please request the proof of income statement right away as it can take a few weeks to receive.

Important to note:

- Late applications will not be accepted.
- Applicants **must** reapply annually.
- Exemptions are granted only for the current year. No retroactive exemptions will be granted.
