

Colchester Clean – Litter Clean Up

Eligibility Requirements for Non-Profit Organizations

Purpose

The Municipality of the County of Colchester values the services provided by local-non profit organizations and the positive impact they have on our community. This donation has been created to provide financial assistance to the first five non-profit organizations that volunteer and participate in the Colchester Clean litter clean up.

Definitions

- a. **“Municipality”** is the Municipality of the County of Colchester.
- b. **“Non-profit Organizations”** are incorporated or registered charities in good standing with the Registry of Joint Stock companies.
- c. **“Litter Clean Up”** is an area that is identified to have litter picked up, bagged and collected for proper disposal from any of the following areas:
 - a. 2.5 km of secondary highways – both sides.
 - b. Carpool parking lot
 - c. Shoreline
 - d. Riverside, brook, or stream
 - e. School yard
 - f. Other (to be pre - approved)

Eligibility

- Only non-profit organizations or registered charities in good standing with the Registry of Joint stock companies.
- Non-profit groups connected to the operating and maintenance of community facilities.

Registration Application

- Registration is available on the Municipality website.
- The completed registration form must be completed prior to Monday April 18, 2022
- Waste Reduction staff will review registration form for eligibility.

Funding

- The eligible registrants will be contacted.
- Funding will be awarded upon the completion of the litter clean up and submission of the data card.
- The first five eligible applicants that have completed the registration process, have their clean up verified and data card submit will each receive \$500.
