

CONSTRUCTION, DEMOLITION AND RENOVATION WASTE



- Construction & Demolition (C&D) waste must be kept separate from regular garbage, recyclables and organic material. It cannot contain any of banned materials.
- If a C&D dumpster contains banned materials or black bags, it will not be picked up.
- Clean Styrofoam such as insulation sheets and packaging pieces are recyclable and should not be placed in a C&D dumpster. Every effort should be made to clean and/or remove contaminants from the Styrofoam so it can be recycled.
- Recyclable Styrofoam CANNOT:
 - **Be saturated with liquid**
 - **Be dirty from mud or food**
 - **Have anything attached/glued to it - for example, cardboard or metal foil**
 - **Contain Rocks or Gravel**
 - **Have tape on it**
- If the Styrofoam is contaminated beyond what would be reasonable effort to remove the contaminants, it should be placed in the garbage.

 - **Insulation**
 - **Vinyl Siding**
 - **Asphalt Shingles**
 - **Drywall/Plaster**
 - **Vapour Barrier**
 - **Metals**
 - **Roofing Materials**
 - **Doors/Windows**
 - **Rugs/Carpeting/Vinyl Flooring**
 - **Counter tops/Cupboards**
 - **Tiles**
