

RENTING A DUMPSTER?

THERE ARE SOME IMPORTANT THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW.

- In Nova Scotia, many different materials are banned from landfill disposal (see list below).
- Any person who generates waste is required to sort all waste and store it properly for pick-up to ensure banned items do not end up in the landfill.
- Any bagged garbage **MUST** be placed in clear bags. Black bags and solid coloured bags are not accepted.
- Dumpsters may be dedicated for individual materials such as cardboard, recyclables or compostable organics, but if the dumpster is designated for garbage it cannot contain the following banned materials:
 - **Automobile Tires**
 - **Hazardous Waste such as Pesticides, Cleaners, Paint, etc.**
 - **Cardboard**
 - **Styrofoam**
 - **Newsprint and other recyclable paper products**
 - **Beverage containers**
 - **Tin cans, Glass Jars and Plastic Containers**
 - **TVs, Computers and other recyclable electronics**
 - **Propane Tanks**
- If a dumpster is designated for Construction and Demolition (C&D) materials destined for a C&D disposal site, nothing but construction and demolition materials may be placed inside (See information relating to Construction, Demolition and Renovation Waste).
