

Balefill Tipping Floor Traffic Controller / Utility Worker **External Posting - Casual On-Call Union Position**

Centrally located within Nova Scotia between two extraordinary coastlines, Colchester is a progressive rural municipality that offers an unparalleled work-life balance. It is a place that is affordable, welcoming, family focused, rich in diverse culture and natural beauty with thriving businesses and access to all the modern amenities typically found in an urban setting – without the common stresses of living in an urban setting.

The Municipality of Colchester is seeking casual on-call Balefill Tipping Floor Traffic Controller/Utility Worker to join our team. Duties include directing traffic on the tipping floor, inspecting incoming loads for banned, hazardous or unbalable materials, separating salvageable materials from refuse, assisting in miscellaneous cleaning and maintenance around the facility, removing snow and litter, operating mobile equipment as required and performing other related duties as directed by the Manager of Balefill and Compost Operations. This is unionized workplace, and the position is located at the Balefill Facility in Kemptown, NS. This position will serve a six-month probationary period, as per article 18.03 of the Collective Agreement.

The successful candidate must have good interpersonal skills to effectively interact with the public, commercial customers, and all levels of staff. Applicants must be in good physical condition and able to report to work on short notice. Reliable transportation and a minimum of class 5 drivers license is required. The ability to operate a loader or other mobile equipment or any type of trucks would be considered an asset. Completion of grade 12 education or GED equivalent is required, or a combination of education, training, experience, and proven ability. Certifications in First Aid/CPR, WHMIS, and other OH&S courses considered an asset.

Hours of work are 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Mondays through Fridays, when required, as scheduled by the Manager. Primarily required during Spring cleanup and on an as needed basis to fill in for vacations and/or sick leaves throughout the remainder of the year. Wage rate is currently \$22.14 per hour.
